Dynamic AI offers Multi-lingual capabilities. At one time, you can support three languages from which the user can choose in the Personal Settings.

The default installation of Dynamic AI comes with the set of:

- English (default)
- German
- Danish

Possible additional languages are:

- Dutch
- Portuguese
- French*
- Hungarian

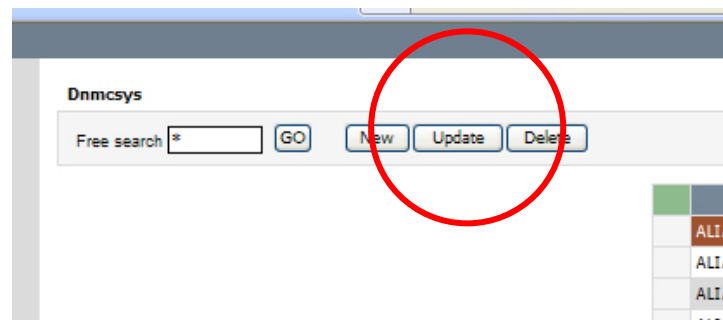
To add one of these languages, you can do the following.

Let's assume you would want to replace the Danish option with the Dutch one. The SYSLANG3 code for Dutch is 'DU'. And let's assume that your current language is set to English (default):

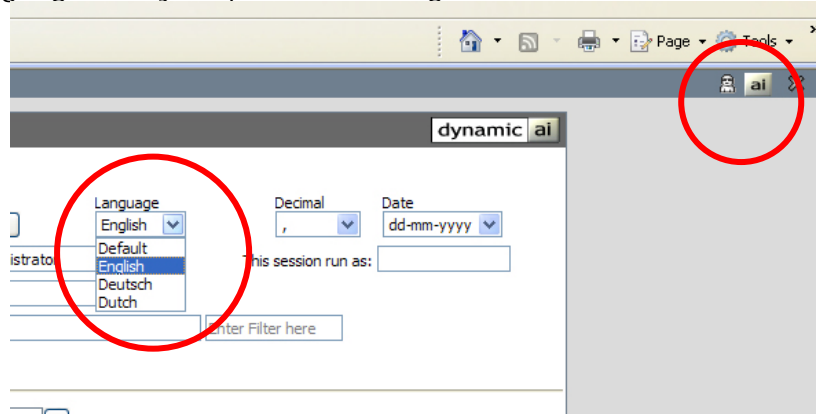
- Choose from the 'Administration' menu the option: 'System Parameters'.
- Find the key 'DNMCSYSLANG3' and change the value to 'DU'.

- Don't forget to 'Update' to make the change effectively.



- Via 'Start' 'Run' in Windows: Start a command-line (CMD) and execute an 'IISRESET'.
- Login into Dynamic AI again. At this time, you can select the Dutch language with your personal settings.



Note:

Performing an IISRESET should in fact not be necessary. However, on some systems we found out, that it does require an iisreset to make the change effective.
